RAPID ACCESS:

Rapid Access:

A focused process for individuals seeking mental health and/or substance use outpatient services. Rapid Access can provide intake appointments for anyone 7 years of age or older.

Scheduling:

You may call the clinic closest to you for a screening at any time. During your screening, you will be given specific details about your intake appointment. Intakes appointments can take up to 90 minutes, so please plan accordingly.

Bring with you:

Photo Id, Insurance card, Medication list, Copayment, and any income verification documents.

Cost:

Insurance Copay/ Sliding Fee/ Full Cost

- Copay- Call your insurance to find your copay
- Sliding Fee- Application can be completed at intake, if uninsured. (Some services do not qualify for sliding scale fee)
- Full Cost- If uninsured and unable to complete sliding fee application you will be responsible for full cost of treatment.

GENERAL THERAPY INFORMATION:

Do you accept insurance?

Encompass Community Supports takes most major insurances. Any questions regarding your coverage, contact your insurance carrier.

Will I have to pay at my visit(s)?

Payment is due at the time of appointment. Non-payment will have your appointment rescheduled.

How long will I need therapy?

Therapy is tailored to the individuals needs. Your clinician will discuss the recommended duration with you.

What if I need medication?

Encompass has limited prescribers on staff. Clinicians and medication providers will work together to determine medication need and management.

Will I get to choose my provider?

You will be assigned a clinician during your intake. Your intake clinician may not be your assigned clinician. If you have any concerns and would like to switch clinicians you will need to contact the clinic manager. It is highly encouraged to discuss any concerns with your clinician to see if they can be resolved.

WHY CHOOSE US?

Our clinic's goal is to provide quality services that empower individuals starting their treatment journey, so they reach their wellness goals.

HOW DO I BEGIN SERVICES?

Contact your closest location to where you live and request an initial "intake evaluation".

*Individuals ages 7-17 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian for appointment.

Missed Appointments

We do understand that situations can arise that may prevent you from coming to your scheduled appointment. If you are aware that you will miss your appointment, please call 24 hours in advance. This helps us better serve others in their own treatment journey.

Missed therapy appointment:

You will be unable to meet with your medication provider until you have met with your clinician.

Missed medication appointment:

You will not be able to receive medication refills
